Bathroom Bardiglio, Carrara and Nero Marquina marbles are combined to create this geometric flooring by Venturoni Studio. The walls are painted in glossy grey enamel with cabinets in Carrara marble and ivory-coloured wood. On the vintage bathtub, a touch of purple comes from the linen bath towel from Society Limonta. The mirrored wall reflects Tom Dixon's 'Press Cone' pendant light, as well as a vintage brass-framed mirror and the 'Etoile' wall lamps from Il Fanale

Bedroom The grey-blue tones of the corridor are brought into this room and enhanced with contrasting burgundy elements, such as the custom-made wardrobe. The 'Bergere' bed by Paola Navone for Gervasoni is topped with a Society Limonta alpaca throw and Mongolian cushion. Next to it, a bronze artwork called *Mother* by Wanderart sits on a 'Piu' table by Guiseppe Viganò for Saba, with one of Bethan Laura Wood's 'Euphorbia' rugs for CC-Tapis underneath. The wall light above the bed is a vintage design from the 1950s ►
